State Police of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern – New Paths to even more Security

FREQUENTIS delivers state-of-the-art networked communication solutions for five command and control centres

The Mecklenburg-Vorpommern "Landesamt für die innere Verwaltung" (State Authority for Internal Administration) ordered Frequentis to provide the Mecklenburg-Vorpommern state police with an emergency call and radio system in April 2008.

The state police of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern enter new paths on the way to even more security. A decisive factor in reaching this goal is the use of sophisticated information and communication technology which will increasingly simplify and facilitate the work of the officials.

The next important step along these paths is the equipping of the command and control centres of the Mecklenburg-Vorpommern state police with state-of-the-art networked communication systems. The Mecklenburg-Vorpommern state authority thus commissioned Frequentis in April 2008 to provide an emergency call handling and radio system. As specialist for communication and information systems, Frequentis came through the tender process as the right partner for this substantial project. The convincing argument in favour of Frequentis was the cost-effective and sophisticated concept for this project.

The schedule is extremely tight since the new communication infrastructure is planned to be operational already in March 2009. The first system to take up service is the command and control centre of the police department Neubrandenburg which went operational on October 9th, 2008. The next systems to follow are the command and control centres in Schwerin, Stralsund and Rostock.

The Frequentis solution based on a 'virtual system' concept offers new possibilities regarding flexibility, resource planning and efficient handling of incidents. In total, 24 operator positions will be equipped completely with new voice communication systems (Frequentis ICCS 3020) and recording systems (DIVOS 3 log).

The five command and control centres of the police in Schwerin, Anklam, Stralsund, Rostock, and Neubrandenburg will be interconnected and will work as ONE system. In the future dispatchers of different command and control centres will be able to control and coordinate large-scale operations together in the 'virtual command and control centre'. The advantage: Operations can be better coordinated and therefore also carried out significantly faster.
