In the near future, maritime, drone management, and ATM traffic optimisation demos will also be added, showcasing the company's commitment to innovation and growth.

Collaborations such as the expansion of Changi Airport and modernisation of ATM systems are indicative of the future direction of Frequentis in Singapore and the broader Asian region. These projects not only underpin the company's commitment to the region but also its dedication to shaping the future of safety-critical communication and information solutions.
