Thomas Karl, Vice President Frequentis Public Transport and authorised officer of Frequentis AG, proudly received a special award for services to the Republic of Austria. During a formal ceremony on 11 December 2019, Federal Minister Andreas Reichhart awarded him the Golden Decoration of Honour.
