In India, Frequentis and Frequentis' Indian/Canadian partner Grintex have developed a unique mobile application to create a seamless, stand-alone device for flight planning. The app's user-friendly interface will ensure a seamless transition for pilots, airlines, and other airspace users already familiar with traditional user terminals, minimising training requirements and maximising productivity.

The Indian aviation industry's potential is immense, with rapid passenger growth and increasing air traffic demands. Frequentis aims to cater to this exponential growth by introducing its state-of-the-art air traffic management solutions.
