Frequentis has signed a major contract with AirNav Ireland, the Air Navigation Service Provider of Ireland, to deliver a state-of-the-art contingency air situation display system (CASDS). AirNav Ireland is modernising its infrastructure to meet evolving air traffic demands and regulatory requirements. To ensure business continuity and avoid common cause failures with the main ATM system, Frequentis will provide a new solution to replace the existing contingency system. This solution includes advanced technologies as well as five years of support and maintenance from Frequentis.
