Together, we are committed to enhancing mission effectiveness and ensuring operational superiority for our customers."

The MOI also provides for ongoing discussions between the parties to review technical and operational requirements as defence needs and technologies evolve. The planned collaboration focuses on knowledge sharing, local support capability, and coordinated program delivery for future opportunities in Saudi Arabia.
